## What we do

Label Stock consists of three layers: facestock, adhesive and release liner.

Our process assembles a wide range of these materials together, depending on the technical requirements and application conditions. This finished product, in reel form, is then warehoused in expectation of orders.

## Our Process



#### COATING

The slitting machines convert and cut the master rolls into various lengths and widths as specified by the customer for their specific job.

#### SLITTING

Morgancoat applies acrylic and hotmelt pressure-sensitive adhesives to a wide range of label substrates for varying applications and packaging/storage conditions.

Our state of the art smart factory in Durban has multiple converting lines with a significant capacity in reserve. We purchase and convert quality raw materials from international flag-ship mills. Our sales and management team have many years of industry experience in the printing and packaging industry.
