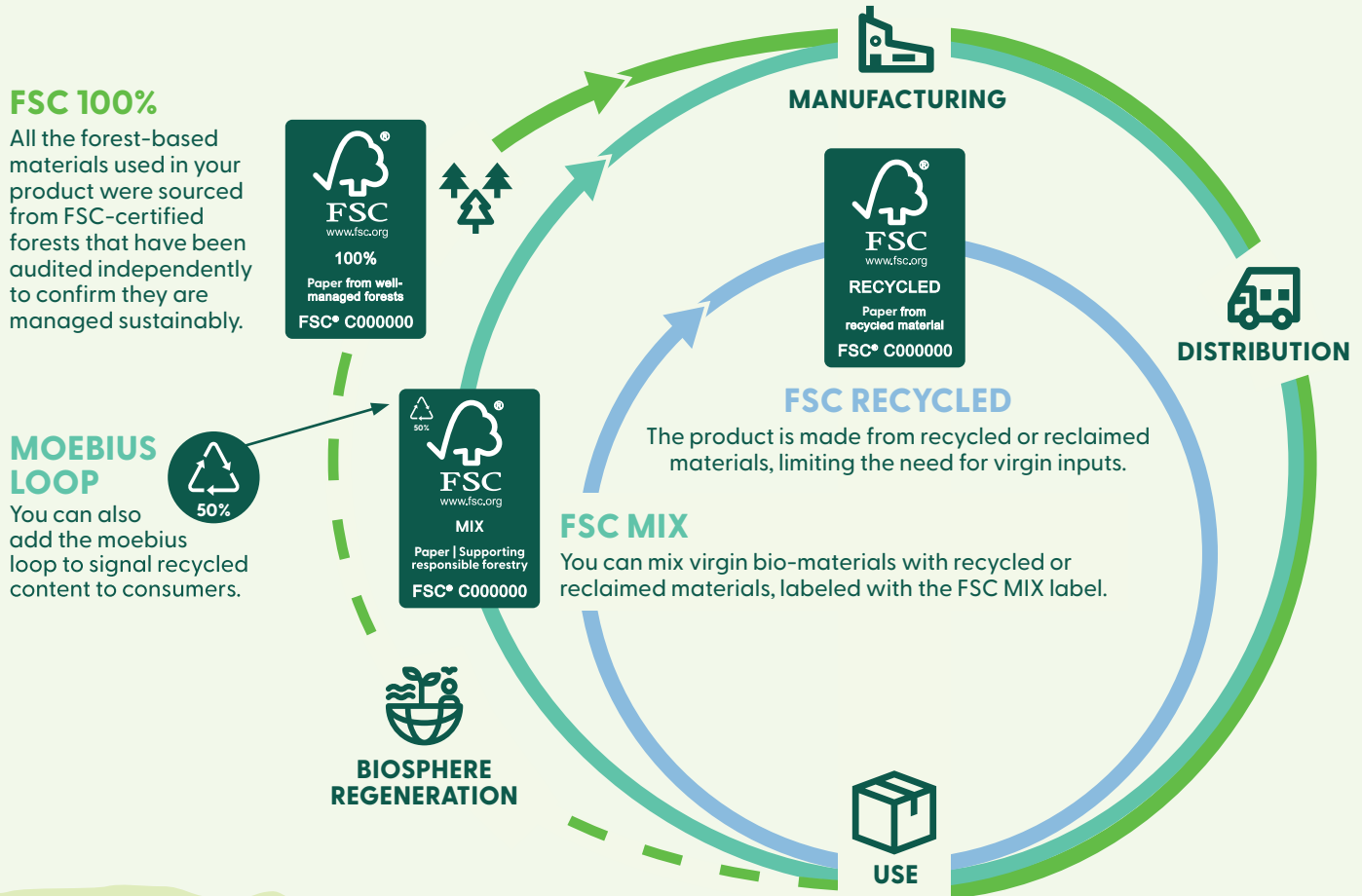


CIRCULARITY STARTS WITH RESPONSIBLE SOURCING
